Soviet history does not continue the Russian evolution but perverts the latter, pushing the country in a new, unnatural direction inimical to the nation's past The terms "Russian" and "Soviet," "Russia" and "the USSR" are neither interchangeable nor contiguous -- these are polar notions which completely exclude one another" [3]
